**Proposal** – Carrie continue as Correspondence Secretary and Kathy as Treasurer – agreed unanimously by members of the Committee

Welcome to the new committee members – Steve, Roimata and Kevin **Proposal** to appoint Kevin Crawford as Minutes Secretary – **moved** Brent and **seconded** Alastair

**Chair -** Brent Page – Brent away overseas approx 4 months from 28 May – proposal for co-Chair – decided not to formalize this role but in the event that Brent was unable to Zoom in whilst away, an attendee would be selected for that meeting.

**Matters arising from the minutes:** Running through the action plan included in the 17 March minutes:

<u>Erica</u>: **Forestry access for Mountain Biking** – It was understood Danny Bay was covering the Forestry Access dialogue with Summit Forests (new owner of Earnslaw One holding) Kate to follow up with Danny Bay for a report back next meeting

Brent: Court Resurfacing refer item below, Pump-Box Enhancement refer item below, Layby planting plan – no response from Higgins to 2 emails / concern re planting season upcoming propose recontact via phone number hopefully obtained by Jenny Crawford from Tanya Patrick TCDC or Kevin Crawford contacts, if no response KRRA do planting – refer detail in item below,

Freedom Camping Bylaw – refer email correspondence with TCDC, Bylaw has been revoked by TCDC as procedurally incorrect but it was not however replaced – this resulting in no enforcement over summer. Brent expressed KRRA concern to TCDC that polite requests by enforcement officers to relocate non-self contained vans and noting max 2 nights to those that were self contained were ineffective. TCDC proposing a new compliant bylaw to include no freedom camping at all in Kuaotunu area. Noted that the roadside park for 3 vehicles between the boat ramp and Bluff Road and boat ramp carpark (this being maintained by TCDC) were

under Waka Kotahi jurisdiction. They were available for free camping but only the latter had toilet facilities

Kathy noted that KRRA has 211 members of which 64 % are paid up (1/3 for 5 years)

# 5. Items for Discussion:

## 5.1 Noticeboard Refresh

Correspondence received from Isabel Gilbert-Palmer (IGP) and followed by presentation from AGM floor by her– for a refresh of the content and appearance of the Noticeboard. The Committee discussed the approach and email content and unanimously applauded Alastair Brickell's weekly maintenance of the items displayed and the content of the board and requested he continues this task for another year.

## 5.2 Request for Service RFS re vegetation overhang on SH25 - at Blackjack turnoff

The road safety issue of visibility heading west after the SH25 bridge due to overhanging vegetation discussed. Brent advised aiming at this trim being included with other cutting of vegetation at the corner.

#### 5.3 Bluff Road rockfall / connection reinstatement

Brent has taken the suggestion at the AGM of Fleming Rasmussen up with Matarangi RR Chair that an incorporated society be setup to advocate for the proposed suspension bridge and

receive external funding. Matarangi Chair, Mark Bedford not keen to add another Inc Society as both Residents and Ratepayers Associations (RRA) were already Inc Societies. Raising funds was considered as premature as TCDC has still not responded with any view on their stance regarding the suspension bridge despite the efforts to contact Bruce Hinson by both KRRA and MRRA Chairs.

Noted that MRRA takes the lead on approaches to TCDC with KRRA in support.

# 5.4 TCDC Annual Plan feedback response from KRRA

TCDC's request for input re the Annual Plan wasn't received in time for KRRA to prepare a formal response. A request for feedback from the community at large was widely publicised.

## 5.5 Request for KRRA input into All about Whitianga

Agreed other forums / publications including our own Newsletter served Kuaotunu sufficiently.

#### 5.6 Request from Coromandel Ratepayers Alliance for KRRA to join

Len Salt of CRRA request for KRRA membership and participation and joint actions with the Alliance was discussed. Noted there already was a meeting with TCDC 4x year of Whangapoua, Opito, Otama and Kuaotunu RRA and this was seen as adequate to represent KRRA interests. Brent Page to have coffee with Len Salt enquire further of proposed activity and express KRRA view above.

# 5.7 TCDC maintenance of Bluff Road connection Cuvier to Rings Beach

AGM item from floor by Diane Barron (Rings Beach resident) on TCDC plans to improve / maintain Cuvier to Rings Beach – Brent has sent an email to Ed Varley TCDC and yet to receive a reply.

## 5.8 Resurfacing of Domain Courts

The Domain Board (DB) has \$27k to contribute to the resurfacing, Danny and Sue Costello (TCDC) met Dugald (our contact with DB) and Dugald notes he will not release funds for concrete resurfacing – refer correspondence.

The Community Board has \$11k to contribute if it is expended prior to 30 June 2022
There are quotes for concrete resurfacing from Peninsula Concrete and synthetic turf from Tiger
Turf (revised with amended layout – refer 28 April email) and Team Turf.

KRRA wants a multi-use facility available to tennis, basketball with hoops added and skaters and skateboarders. Noted that TigerTurf over the full area does not serve that multipurpose function. KRRA recognises that the best outcome is a community consensus of all funding parties on the resurfacing material.

Kevin noted important that any concrete resurfacing is done to appropriate standards and further detail needs to be requested from Peninsula Concrete as to the specification in their quote and Sue Costello TCDC informed of this.

**Action**: Alastair to approach Dugald to explain KRRA's position and need to have a multipurpose outcome and ideally confirm DB funding contribution to concrete resurfacing.

**Resolution**: Committee agrees to allocate KRRA funds as a contribution to a multipurpose recreational resurfacing of the existing slab to a value of up to \$7k based on KRRA recommendation to Sue Costello (TCDC) – email 20 April 2022 **moved**: Brent **seconded**: Carrie.

# 5.9 SH25 Layby on Kuaotunu Hill

Committee agreed to reapproach Higgins (Ben Buttimore) for a planting layout plan and programme for the now bare land at the layby—Brent to re-approach Higgins by email and phone and failing that inform Tanya Patrick and get advice on planting type. Jenny Crawford to obtain Ben's ph number from Tanya or Kevin via Higgins contact and send to Brent.

# 5.10 Siting of additional Pohutukawas from TCDC

Responsibility for siting the 4 pohutukawas on the Reserve that are owed from TCDC agreed to be **Jenny Crawford and Tanya Patrick** (TCDC) – should be 3 more replacing those lost in floods or have died -refer Tanya email 28 April. Proposed Location: replacement of two washed away from streambank opposite store and also along perimeter of estuary to north. Tanya comments that adjacent the road is not practical (conflicts with services) and prefers side of estuary offset from bank so that not vulnerable to further flood erosion.

# 5.11 Drone Footage of coastline for Kuaotunu Dune Care restoration planning

Keith Goodall utilised Richardson's Real Estate drone to capture the area from Cuvier to the Blackjack Reserve in zones for an inventory of the condition of the dunes and for planning of restoration. Agreed to record KRRA thanks to Keith for undertaking this and Kevin proposed a typical aerial to be added as an item to the next Newsletter.

### 5.12 Pump House Beautification on the Blackjack Reserve

Discussed that the outcome to be a woodwork artistic treatment of the existing bench and ugly vertical portion – possibly enable it to be a seat with stair or step to climb up / view shaft west whilst still accessing power box on the rear side (this also could be artistically treated as an opening door for example). KRRA interested to make contribution to artist to agreed Woodwork concept – **Roimata** to advance this.

Water testing is underway results shortly – if drinkable there is potential drinking fountain / water bottle filling tap funded by TCDC.

### **5.13 Traffic Calming**

TCDC have a number of options and as yet not shared with KRRA – Brent to request from Ed Varley and / or Bruce Hinson so that there is community input into any proposal **Brent** to continue to advocate for road markings and speed limit lowering with Bruce Hinson and with TCDC Councillor nominees in Local Body elections.
